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REPORT OF THE STUDENT'S OVERALL EVALUATION OF THE PROGRAMME AND TEACHING

(STUDENT SATISFACTION SURVEY)

Year (2018-19)

Student's Evaluation of the programme and teaching is a part of educational procedures and it helps to improve an educational program, assess its achievements and revamp its effectiveness. It is a systematic process of collecting, analyzing and interpreting information to determine the extent to which B.Ed. trainees are achieving instructional and behavioral outcome. Student's overall evaluation of the academic programme and teaching was based on the 85 performances which was collected from the B.Ed. Trainees of the year 2018. The interpretation of the feedback given by 85 students based on the following points vis-à-vis Teacher, Course, Internal Assessment, and Library.

A. Teacher

- Teacher's approach can best be described as always courteous 85%, always indifferent 10%, sometimes rude 5%.
- She/he prepares the classes thoroughly 85%, poorly 13%, satisfactorily 2%.
- She/he encourages student participation in the class mostly yes 85% and sometime 15%.
- She/he communicates in always effective 80%, just satisfactorily 18% and sometime effective 2%.
- She/he uses encouraged to raise 81%, questions 11%, get involved in discussion 6% and did not encourage 2% method to teach the students.
- She/he provides regular/ in time 86% and with helpful comments 14% feedback on student's performance.
- Assignments were discussed in class yes, fully 82%, not discussed at all 8%, yes partly 9% and sometime discussed 1%.
- Her/his advice was very helpful 85%, not all helpful 3%, sometime helpful 10% and did not advise 2%.

B. Course

- The syllabus of each course was adequate 85%, challenging 5%, in adequate 10%.
- It was covered in class up to 85% to 100% were 85%, 70% to 85% were 9%, 55% to 70% were 6% and less than 55% were 0%.

- The course contributory lecture was provided in the beginning yes 85% and no 15%.
- Background for benefiting from the course was more than adequate 77%, adequate 13%, inadequate 10%.
- The course was easy 80%, difficulty 6%, manageable 10% and very difficult 4% to understand for students.

C. Internal Assessment

- Internal assessment was always fair 86%, usually unfair 1%, sometimes unfair 6% and some time fair 7%.
- It helps to improve course grade with helps to improve 90%, no special effect 2%, discouraging 1% and some time effective 7%.

D. Library

- Library material and facilities for the course was more than adequate 85%, inadequate 13%, adequate 1% and very poor 1%.
- Students get prescribed reading materials easily 91%, not available at all 7% and with some difficulty 2%.

Professional Growth of Teacher

- Teachers published research paper in National & International UGC approved/ Refereed Journals.
- They presented research paper in National & International Seminars/Conferences.

Remedial Measures to be taken to improve the Feedback system

- The courteousness of teacher as appeared from the feedback report is 85%. It is a
 fact that respect and courtesy goes a long way with teacher. To inculcate courtesy,
 some play way methods; activity etc. should be employed to ensure warmth while
 teaching them.
- Participation of students in class is 85%. Assess student's prior knowledge and tailor the lesion to build on students already know and it will increase the rate and degree of learning.
- Teacher must show interest in student's opinion then they will feel that their ideas or thoughts are appreciated and it will increase their self-confidence.
- Teacher should foster an ethos of student's participation and well-timed opportunities for them to work together. They will feel successful and more encouraged when new content is linked to what they already know.

- Proper schedule of assignments of every subject must be prepared in advance and should be discussed with students and them feedback will be generated. Due to time problems some topics are left and it can be given as assignments/projects of the uncovered topics.
- To make the course more understandable, teaching techniques like cooperative learning, project based learning, inquiry based instruction should be employed.
- Visual aids such as smart boards and projectors can ramp up the lesson in class.
 Students will absorb information and have deep understanding of it from hearing lecture along with it.




Q 1. The teacher's approach can best described as?







Q 2. How much well did the teacher prepare for the class?







